After spaying these cats, I will try to find them good homes and care for them until then. I live in the country and care for 5 cats, 3 are strays that have been here and all are fixed. The last two are new and are getting well fed.



My wife is unemployed and diagnosed with cancer. We have no help such as food stamps or disability. We have 3 dogs who are spayed already and have one more dog who needs to be.



I have 18 dogs and I am getting 8 females fixed and 5 puppies. The rest are males.



I am spaying one dog. I have two more dogs to have spayed but I have to wait until I get more money because I really don't have much. But as soon as I do I would like to have them done. The only income that I have is \$150 a month mowing grass in the summer.



My husband and I are both on disability and are raising our 9 year old granddaughter. Her dad, our son, passed away and she was taken from her mother when she was 5. She found a stray dog and fell in love with it. Our area is known for people dumping cats and dogs, several of our neighbors have taken in strays. Abby is the dog's name and she is 1 1/2 years old.



I am on full disability. I do not get any other assistance (like food stamps). I have a chronic illness. Maverick, my 3 year old Siberian husky, is my only companion. The apartment management where I live wants me to get him neutered or they might evict me. Thank you.



My biggest problem is I already have too many cats. I have at least 30 kittens, 10 adult females and 4 adult males. I have 8 females that have been spayed. I tried to get my cats all spayed about 2 years ago. I almost had it done. I only have about 6 then, but 3 more pregnant females showed up that summer. My heart won't let me turn a sick or hungry animal away. I've been on disability all summer and we don't have a lot of extra money. If you can help me stop my cats from breeding, I will be able to care for what I have until I have find homes for them.



If anyone knows of any good low-cost programs for south central IN I'd be greatly appreciative. I'm currently fostering 14 kittens born to 3 of our strays in the neighborhood. We're a household on a very fixed income and can't afford \$70 services for 14 kittens, 7 adult cats outside plus the 2 unaltered females we have in the house. HELP!

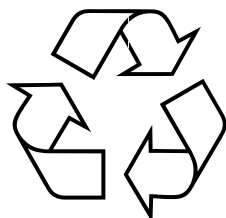
