Dear Veterinarian:

Spay-Neuter Services of Indiana (SNSI) would like to invite you to participate in the programs we run. If you're not familiar with SNSI, we are a statewide financial assistance organization, serving Indiana residents, rescue group and municipal shelters.

Vets are welcome to join any and all of our programs, and participating vets are welcome to determine the number of surgeries they perform for SNSI. SNSI's reimbursement rates are listed in the enclosed contract.

SNSI's programs include:

1. The **Spay-Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP)** is our flagship program. SNAP serves limited-income pet owners, as they are more likely to not afford the cost of a spay/neuter surgery.
2. SNSI also assists municipal shelters and 501(c)(3) organizations by providing them with 10 free surgery certificates each year. Many of these groups operate on shoestring budgets, and our support allows them to assist more animals. The certificates are issued through our **Pet Friendly Group Grant (PFGG)** program.
3. We also have a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program for **Community Cats**. The number of requests for help with community cats has increased, as people have learned about feral and free-roaming cats, and what they can do to care for them. Please note that the contract includes a reimbursement rate specifically for Community Cats, which includes: surgery, rabies vaccine, pain meds, and ear-tip.

Please review the enclosed contract and select the services that best suit your clinic. Once again, we cannot thank you enough for your participation in our programs and for the service you provide to your community!
